Conduct comprehensive diagnostics and support the establishment of Corridor Performance Observatories to identify bottlenecks (border crossing times, transport costs, infrastructure conditions) and harmonize methodologies.	Shipping & Logistics Specialist - UNICEF, DRC (2019-2020): I led an extensive strategic evaluation of regional transport corridors, infrastructure networks, and border-crossing performance across 18 provinces. This involved tracking and analyzing efficiency metrics for major regional ports (Dar es Salaam, Mombasa, Matadi, Pointe Noire, Beira) and road transit corridors crossing Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, Tanzania, and Kenya. By mapping operational bottlenecks and evaluating Long-Term Agreement (LTA) logistics providers using data-driven indicators, I proved my capability to establish and manage performance observatory frameworks for complex regional transport networks like those within ECOWAS.
